Re-Amazing Grace

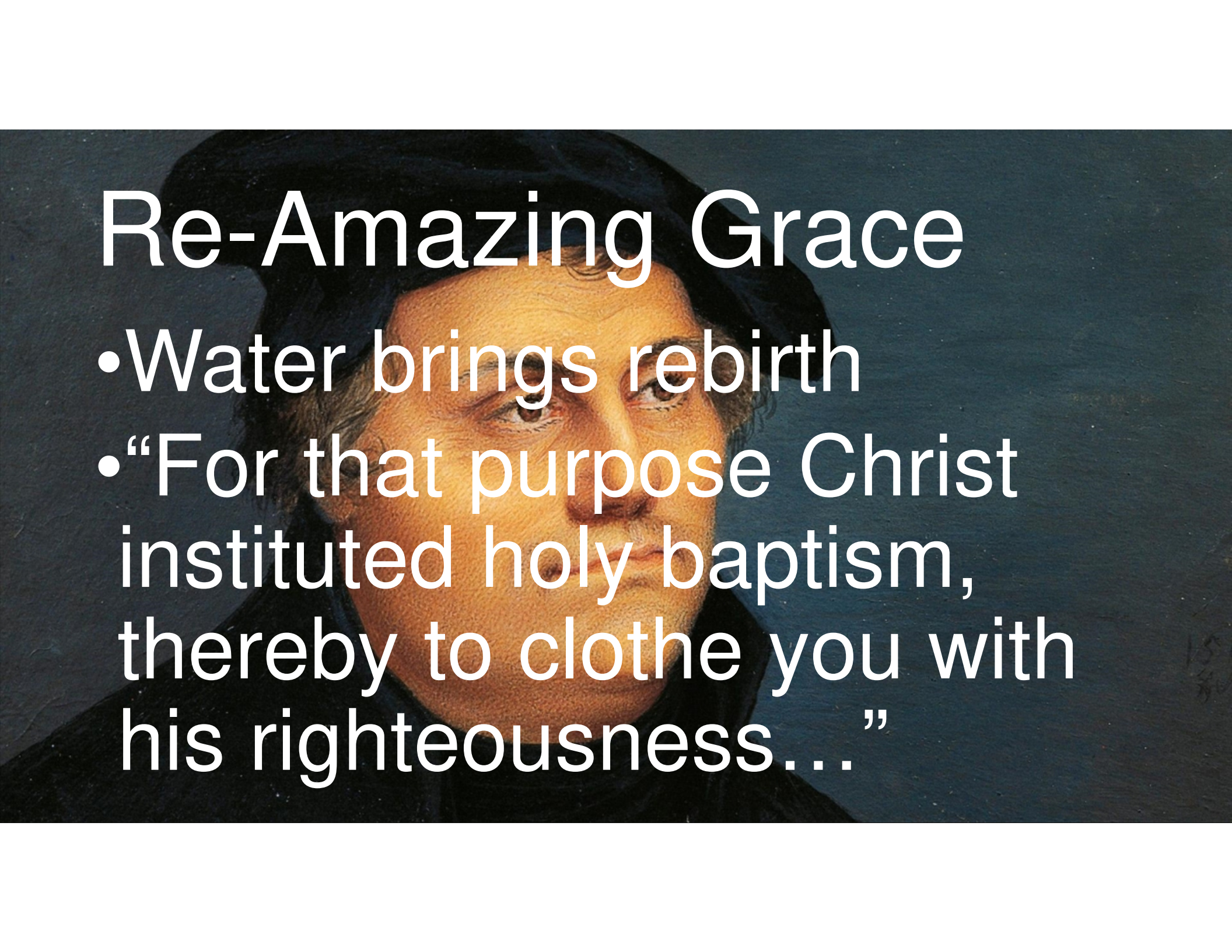
- A womb contained God!

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- ... for the angels have long arms, and although they stand before the face and in the presence of God and his son Christ, yet they are hard by and about us....” (Martin Luther)

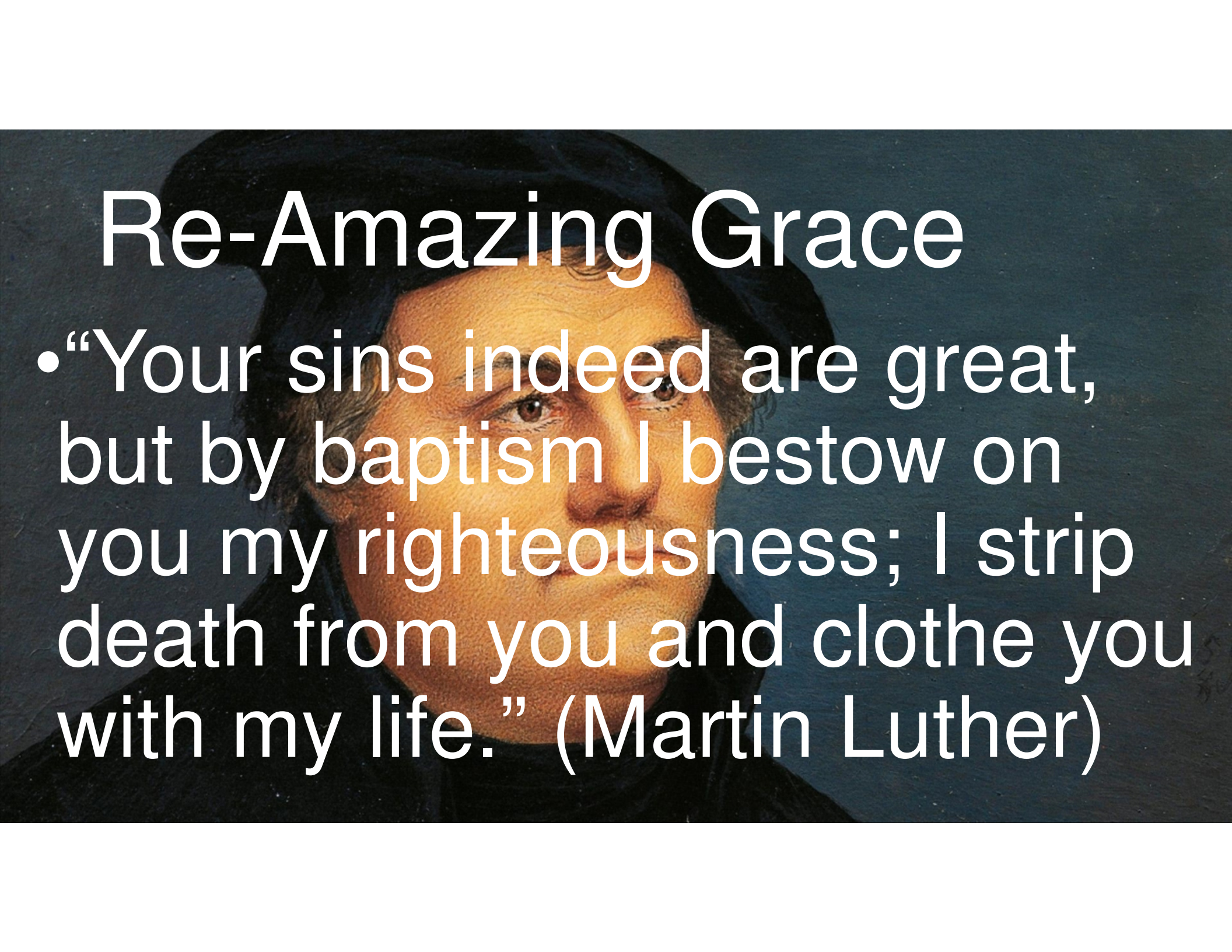

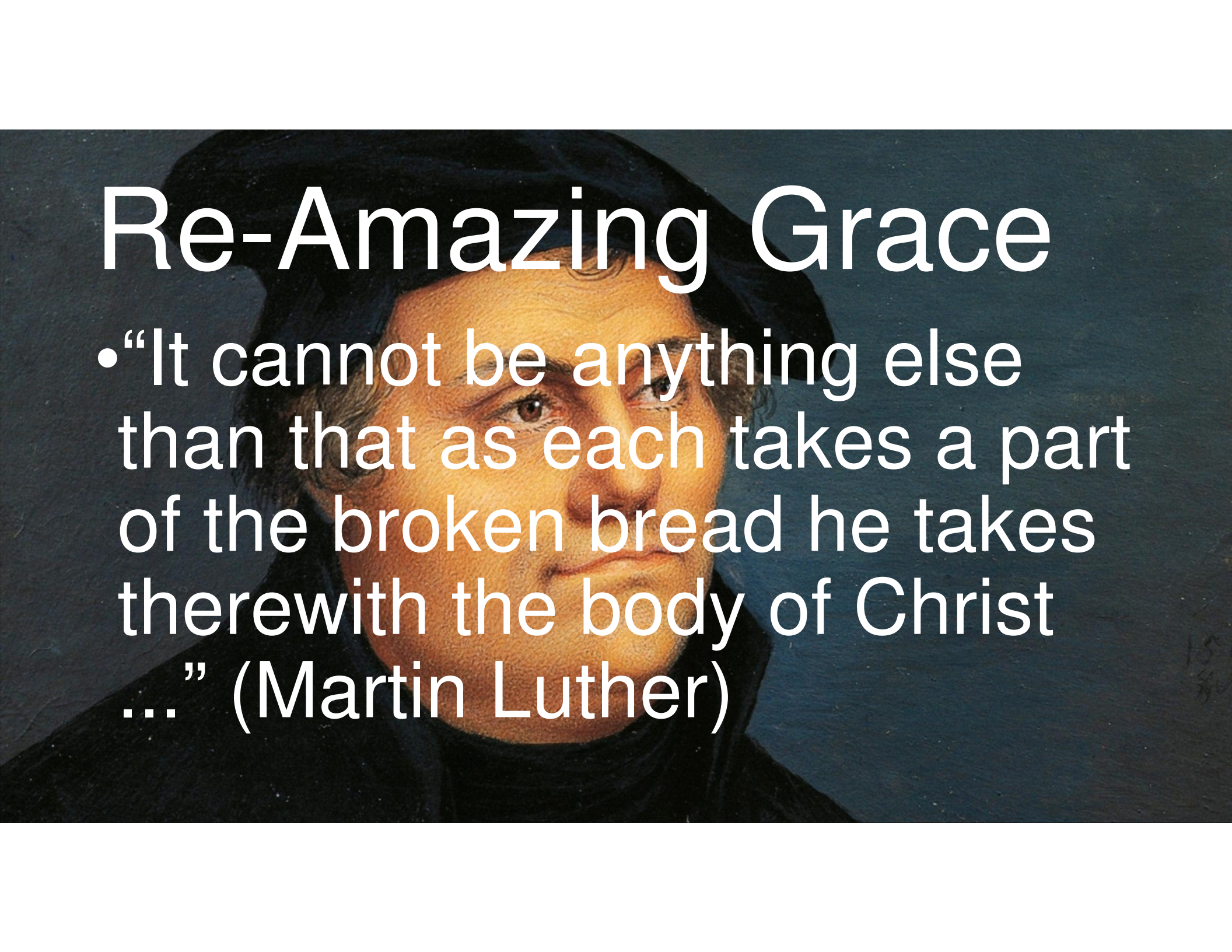
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- A wafer is the Body of Christ.
