Washrooms: located in the narthex and Education Wing, upstairs and down.

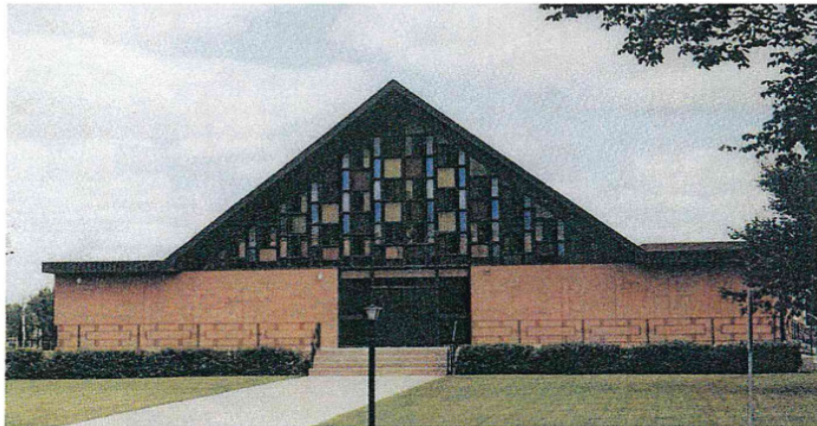
Elevator: located next to the church office.
